Many languages have constructions in which verbs cluster. But few languages have verb clusters as rich and complex as Continental West Germanic and Hungarian. Furthermore the precise ordering properties and the variation in the cluster patterns are remarkably similar in Hungarian and Germanic. Through a close textual analysis of three science fiction novels, the author expands East German literary history to include science fiction as a valuable source for developing a multi-faceted understanding of the country's short history. Finally, an epilogue notes new titles and developments since the fall of the Berlin Wall.

The Logic of Artificial Life - Harald Schaub 2004

Artificial Life is a still growing interdisciplinary research field integrating a variety of different theoretical foundations, methodological positions, applications and disciplines. The main focus of this science is to abstract and to

synthesize the essential features and dynamics of living systems in order to create artificial, life-like systems. On a regular basis and from 1995 on the German Workshop on Artificial Life is organized. Like previous workshops the 6th German Workshop on Artificial Life in 2004 provided the opportunity for scientists from a broad spectrum of research areas to get in touch with their colleagues from different disciplines, to learn from one another about questions of mutual interest and to have a forum for scientists who would like to get into contact with the Artificial Life community. Contributions to the GWAL 2004 result from research efforts from (and may be of interest to) biology, physics, information and computer science, chemistry, mathematics, psychology, sociology, philosophy, robotics, socionics and much more.

Theorie und Management komplexer Projekte - Dietmar Lucht 2018-11-11

Im vorliegenden Buch wird die These aufgestellt, dass der Versuch, eine rigide, alle Projekttypen erfassende Projektmanagement-Methodik zu entwickeln, nicht zielführend ist. Zeitlich begrenzte Organisations-Projekte mit einem überschaubaren Budget und wenigen

involvierten Akteuren haben mit öffentlichkeitswirksamen Vorhaben im Infrastruktur-, Immobilien- oder Großforschungsbereich kaum mehr gemeinsam als den Namen. Inhouse-Projekte mit einer vorübergehenden Veränderung der Linienorganisation sind anders zu steuern als kommerziell ausgerichtete Unternehmungen der Projektindustrie. Entscheidend aber ist der Grad ihrer Komplexität. Projekte scheitern häufig, große Projekte besonders oft. Aber warum? Aufbauend auf eine detaillierte Analyse, wie Projektkomplexität zu fassen ist, werden in diesem Buch die wichtigsten Projektmanagement-Standards und -Normen in Bezug auf die Anforderungen von Großprojekten untersucht. Im Ergebnis wird deutlich, dass sich Projekte mit einer geringen und mittleren Komplexität erfolgreich mit den klassischen Managementmethoden bearbeiten lassen. Überschreiten sie jedoch eine gewissen Komplexitätsschwelle, bedarf es einer Erweiterung des Modellansatzes und davon ausgehend eines Projektmanagements 2.0. Das Buch hinterfragt die „Kategorie Projekt“ unter Anwendung der Theorie sozialer Systeme sowie moderner Organisationstheorien neu auf ihren Inhalt, ihre Spezifik und ihre Grenzen. Es wird deutlich, dass komplexe Projekte nur „dialektisch“, in einer Dichotomie von Prozessablauf und temporärer Organisation, zu verstehen sind. Insbesondere ihre Ausprägung als zeitweiliges Organisations- und rekursives Entscheidungssystem ist noch ein weitgehend blinder Fleck der bisherigen Projekttheorie. Der Autor setzt auf Methodenpluralität. Dem widerspricht nicht, dass es auf einer aggregierten Ebene verallgemeinerungsfähige Denkansätze gibt, wie Großprojekte zu bewältigen sind. In einem abschließenden Kapitel werden dazu Ideen entwickelt und Charakteristika komplexer Projekte, wie Zielkomplementaritäten, iterative Projektabläufe und Prinzipal-Agent-Probleme, untersucht.
